WHAT IS THIS SUMMER CAMP ABOUT?

Together with children and educators we will have fun, creating, exploring and learning as we develop Spanish language.

Each module will address different questions from our environments, from the smallest to the largest. Art and science will serve as tools to immerse ourselves in a joyful and enriching summer.

Objectives

We want to create an environment for learning for children and staff through innovative methodologies that will allow us to explore ourselves and the world around us.

- 1. Create a safe, comfortable and stimulating environment for the learning processes of all involved.**
- 2. Deploy routines, establish rules and determine roles that allow self-observation and learning through the continuous exchange of experiences and ideas in Spanish.**
- 3. Motivate a creative exploration of the themes that is flexible and multidisciplinary, allowing teachers and children to generate multiple connections through mindfulness and self discovery!**

Eligibility

- Children must be 3 years old before they start camp and not older than 8 years old.
- Children of all abilities are welcome to the Camp. However, we need to have a meeting to develop an accommodation plan to find out if the camp can accommodate your family needs.

artist educator

Our curriculum is designed so that all the participants in this experience have the opportunity to shine at all times.

The role of the artist educator is liberating and flexible to the extent that it opens up possibilities for their personal expressions and interests and to dialogue with content and collective dynamics.

Artist who make up the staff are invited to discover, create and explore with the children from their intuition and their tastes supported by the materials and the regular dynamics that will be implemented in the summer.

Each teacher will be in charge of a group and will be responsible for creating a weekly activity from their specific area of knowledge.
